Refrain from Part-time Jobs and Drinking in the  
“Special Area for Infection Prevention in Fukui” (Alert)

The number of confirmed cases of COVID-19 has recently increased in Fukui prefecture, and the prefecture has declared its own state of emergency. The prefecture has also specified the downtown area (Junka 1-2, Chuo 1-3, Ohte 1-3) as a “Special Area for Infection Prevention”, with intense controls being implemented.

In the University of Fukui, some students who worked part-time jobs or went for a drink in the area have been diagnosed with COVID-19 recently. Some more students who did the same things have had close contact with infected people.

The University of Fukui strongly asks students to refrain from working part-time jobs or going drinking in that “Special Area for Infection Prevention” in order to prevent infection spread and secure the safety of students’ campus life. In addition, in the case that your school restricts or bans part-time jobs, you must follow the directions.
